Just a little reminder that the school opens its doors at 8.40am each day, when children come into school ready for the register at 8.50am. Children who are not in class at this time receive a Late mark (code L). Should your child arrive late after the registers have closed, then a different Late mark is given (code U) – this is classed as an unauthorised absence.

Please be aware that the playground is not supervised before 8.40am, and as such, you need to ensure your children are safe before school times. Please make sure children are not left on their own before this time.
