### Children's Bags

In a bid to keep our school cloakroom areas as tidy as possible, we request that you keep the sizes of bags to a minimum. Cloakrooms are often shared by 60 children and so, you will appreciate, we do not have the space for 60 large bags.

Reading books and homework books should fit into a bag which is no bigger than a book bag.

PE kits should ideally be in drawstring bags that can be hung on a peg, under coats. In order to make sure your child's kit is available for PE lessons, it is ideal if it comes into school on Monday, and goes home on Friday each week.
