ROBIN HOOD'S BAY TRIP 2016

All of our Year 6 pupils are invited to take part in our exciting residential trip to the beautiful Robin Hood's Bay on the Yorkshire coast. The trip will take place next summer from Monday 5th June until Friday 9th June (5 days and 4 nights).

Full board accommodation is included at The Old School House in Robin Hood's Bay consisting of a cooked breakfast, packed lunch and three course evening meal. Whilst staying in Robin Hood's Bay we will be enriching the learning experiences of the topics they have learnt at school by visiting the beach which is renowned on the east coast for fossil hunting with ammonites regularly unearthed in the sand & shingle. We will also be exploring nearby Whitby Abbey on a day excursion, with a boat trip included. One morning will be spent at Eden Camp, an old World War 2 prisoner of war camp, discovering first-hand about life during the War. Further activities will also be organised for children on the beach at Robin Hood's Bay and planned visits from local story tellers will enrich the children's experience. On our journey to Robin Hood's Bay we will be visiting the renowned, and recently refurbished, Jorvik Centre and our return journey will include a visit to Sherwood Forest Nature Reserve, the legendary stomping ground of Robin Hood.

The cost of the trip is budgeted to be between £220 and £260, depending on numbers taking part. This will cover travel, insurance, hotel rooms, food and all visits. If you would like your child to take part a £55 non-refundable deposit is required along with your consent. This can be made via School Gateway and needs to be completed by Monday, 21st November. As soon as the final numbers are known you will receive a confirmation letter of your child's place on the trip and details of the payment instalment options.
