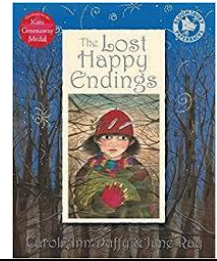

Focus Book: The Lost Happy Endings

English

The children will read The Lost Happy Endings. This is a traditional story in the style of a fairytale. The children will be writing an alternative ending with an alternative villain. Their story will use adverbs, conjunctions and prepositions. The children will be analysing how settings are used to create atmosphere. The children will develop their speaking and listening skills by orally describing their villain and using oral description to draw a picture of the villain.

Maths

In Maths during this half term the children will be looking at length, mass and volume. This is on the central theme of measurement. The children will learn how to use scales, rulers and measurement jugs. They will then using the strategies previously taught to solve word problems.

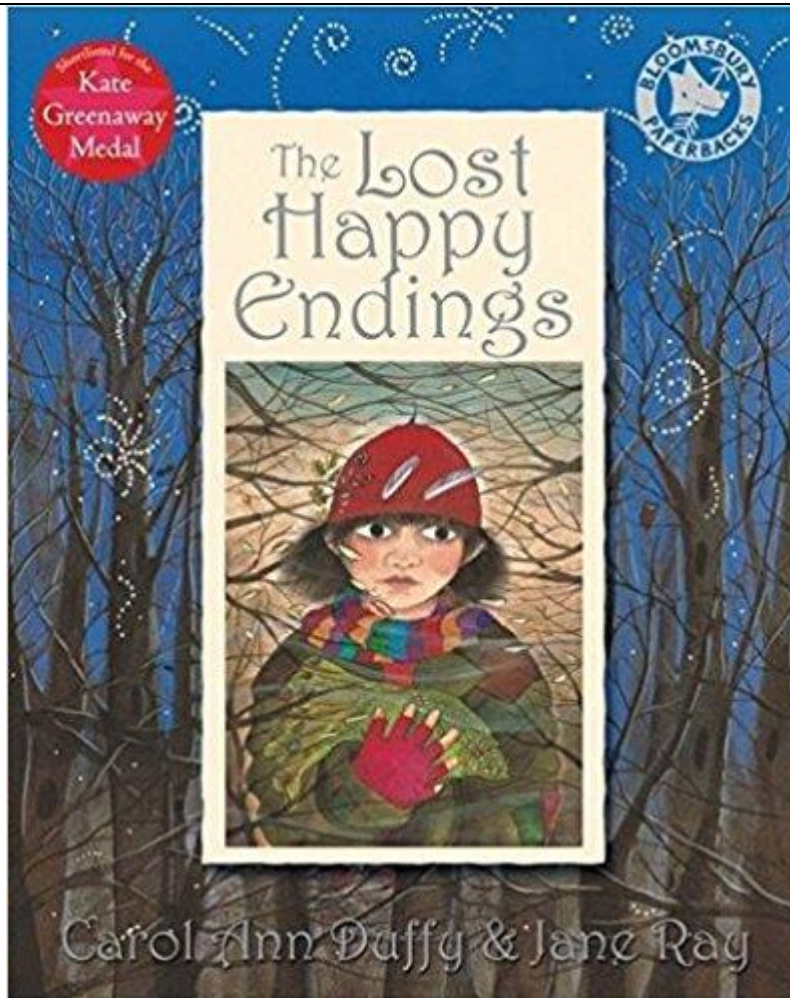
Investigate the past and find evidence to support their reasoning.
