	Mastery: Today, you will be learning to represent algebra visually and interpreting diagrams. You will be completing questions throughout the video as well as the main task at the end. These will all include addition and subtraction to finding missing numbers (solving algebraic equations). Task: Complete the questions towards the end of the video. The first and sixth one has been modelled. If you complete this, you can try the HOT Challenge. Finally, there is a plenary question to have a go at.	Mastery: Today, you will be learning to represent algebra visually and interpreting diagrams – similar to yesterday, however focusing on multiplication and division. You will look at a range of diagrams and interpret them using algebra. You will then be solving questions as you did in the previous lesson. They will involve multiplication and division. Task: Complete the questions towards the end of the video. If you complete this, you can try the HOT Challenge. Finally, there is a plenary question to have a go at.	Mastery: In Maths today, you will be simplifying equations. You will be looking at a diagram and interpreting what it is representing. You will then workout how you can manipulate of change the equation so that you can find the missing value. You will have a go at a range of these questions throughout the video. You must make sure you complete and submit these questions. Task: Complete the questions towards the end of the video. If you complete this, you can try the HOT Challenge. Finally, there is a plenary question to have a go at.	Mastery: In Maths, you will be applying your algebra knowledge to solving problems. We will work through a range of problems using bar models, algebraic equations and calculations to solve them. This will be repeated for 3 problems so you are able to see different ways this could be completed. Task: Complete the questions on at the end of the video. These will be similar to questions you are already seen throughout the lesson but with different numbers. Therefore, you may wish to go back through the video to remind yourself of how to complete the question.	Mastery: Today's maths lesson will be similar to yesterday's as we will be applying our algebra knowledge to solve problems. However, today you will be looking at abstract calculations (so, they will not have a story behind them like the word problems). We will work throug examples of these using similar techniques to the previous lesson. Task: Complete the questions towards the end of the video. Remember use the questions w have completed throughout the video to help you!
