### Re: See-Saw

We are pleased to be able to share with you some exciting news about our remote learning plans for the summer term.

To help all families with our remote learning, we will be focusing on a whole-school theme of 'Weather Warriors' for the first half-term, which means that learning for many subjects will be around a similar theme for all year groups – and tailored for their needs. **English and Maths will continue to have year group specific learning for them.**

The learning will be shared with you through See-Saw – a learning platform. You can find it at [www.seesaw.com](http://www.seesaw.com) or download the app through the app store. **Every child will have their own code to access this (they do not need an email address).** We have posted their code to them in a letter – which you should receive by the weekend. The letter also contains a little gift. Please look out for it!

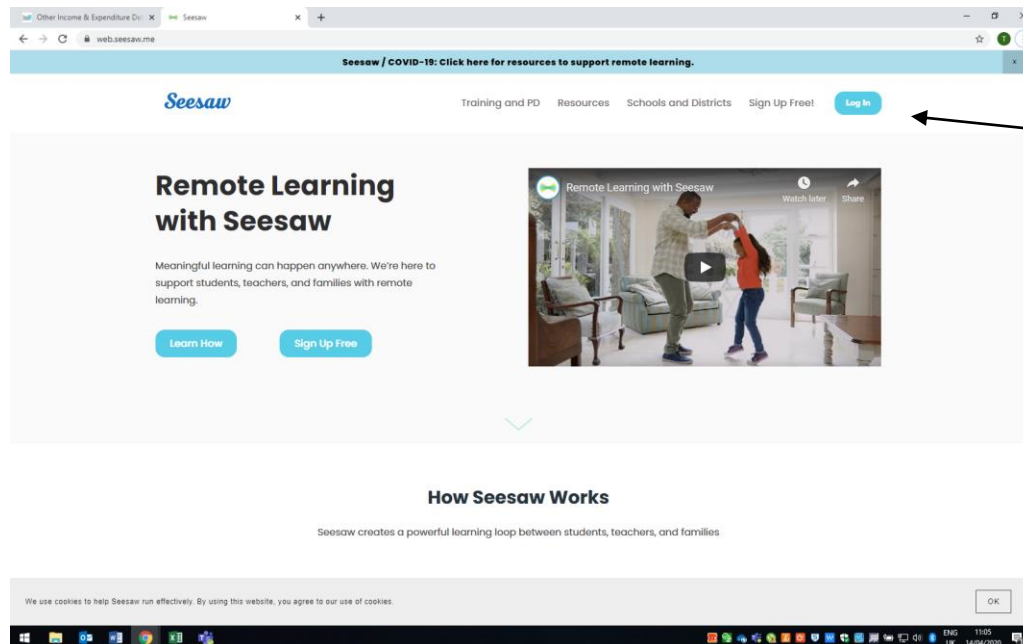
From Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April, the learning activities will appear on See-Saw for your child. They can then complete them on See-Saw or photograph them (and upload them to See-Saw) for their teacher to be able to see their learning, and provide feedback on it for them.

A video to assist with how it works will be placed on the website in the very near future. To get started, the following notes below may be helpful.

To start off, you will need to go to [www.seesaw.com](http://www.seesaw.com).



You will then see this screen:



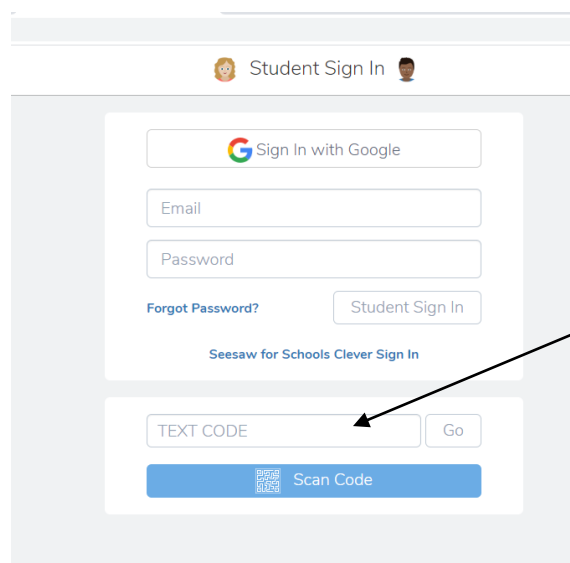
Click 'Log in'.

You will then be taken to this screen:



Click on 'I'm A Student'.

You will then be taken to this screen:



THE ONLY THING YOU NEED HERE IS YOUR CODE. DO NOT TRY TO PUT IN AN EMAIL ADDRESS.

Type in your code (the text code), and it will take you to your home screen.  
The code will be sent to your child in the post – look out for it!



Your page has a few places to look at. Please watch the video on the school website to help you.

It will look a little like this one, but for your class eg.KB5. You will find your activities set for you – by clicking on Activities, and by clicking on your name, and the folder by the side of it. Complete an activity by clicking on it in your folder – then, using a variety of tools provided (draw, upload a photograph, and write) complete the activity. Click on the green tick you see in the top corner to save and send it to your teacher.
