  - Outdoor clothing – waterproofs, wellies and spare change of clothes.
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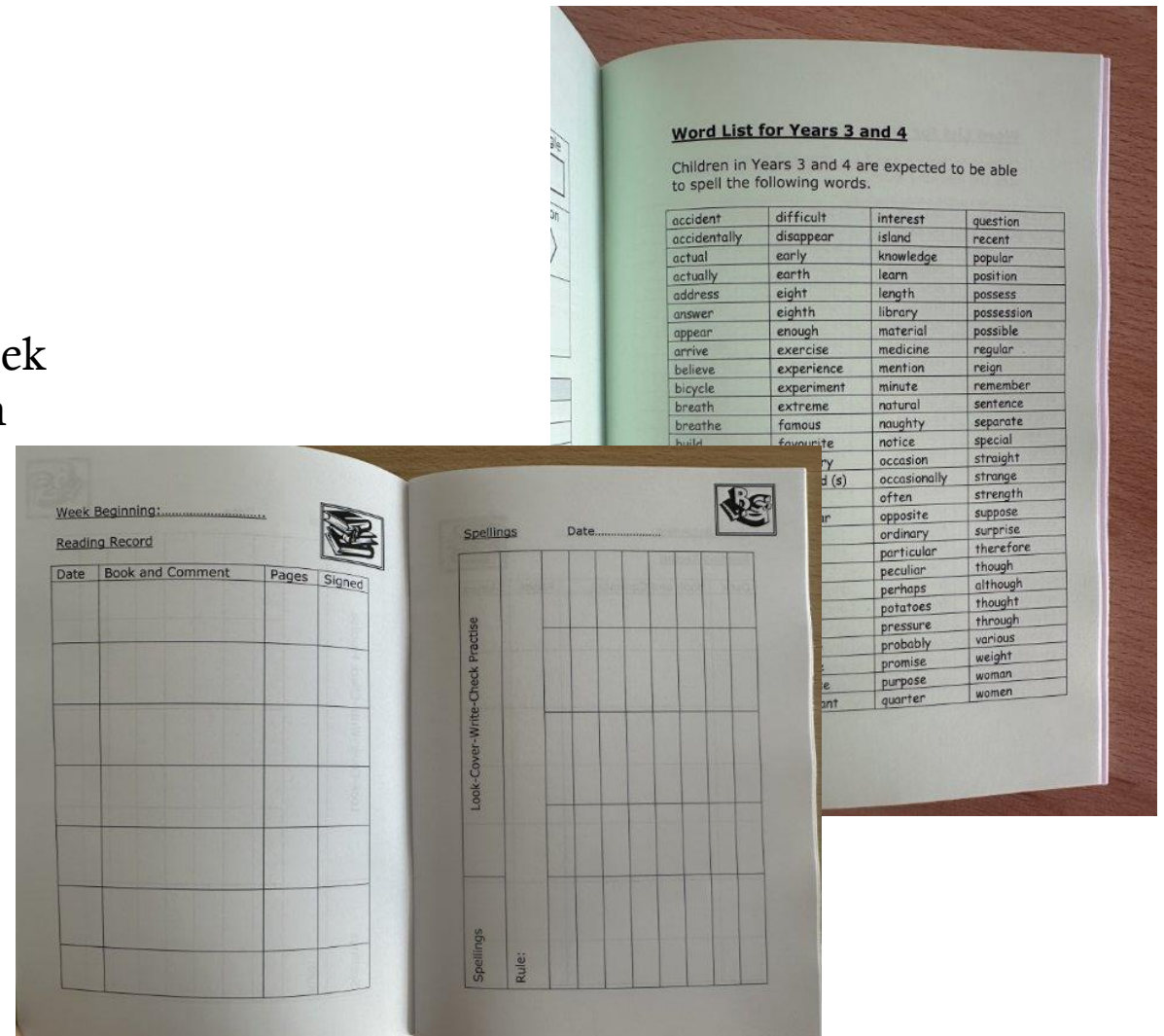
# HOMEWORK

- The aim is to be reading for a few minutes each day.



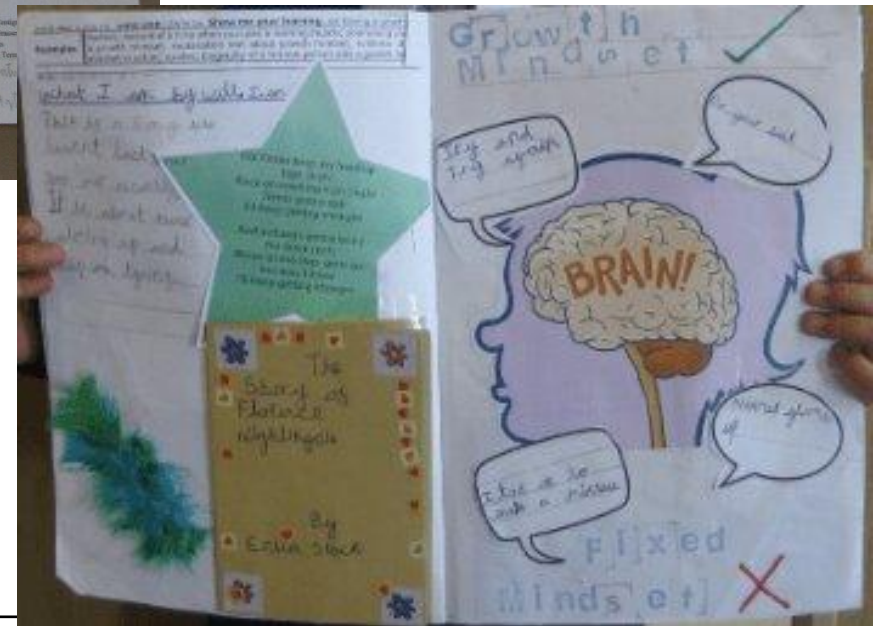
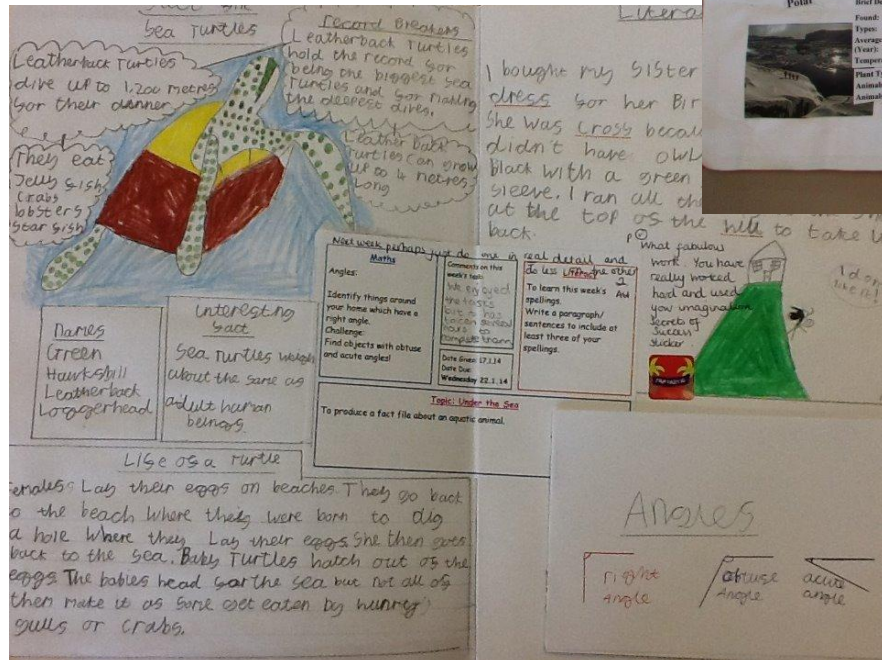
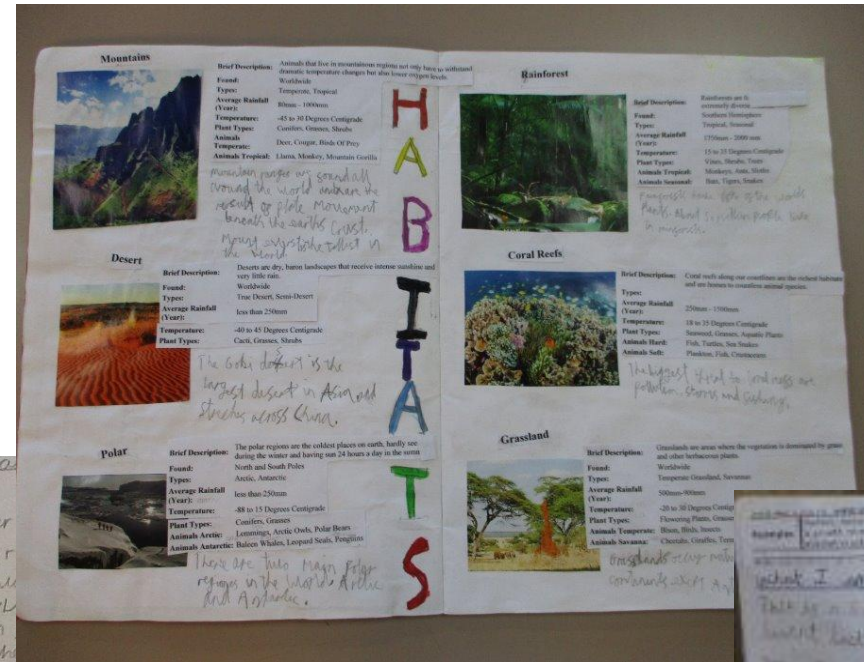
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# HOMEWORK

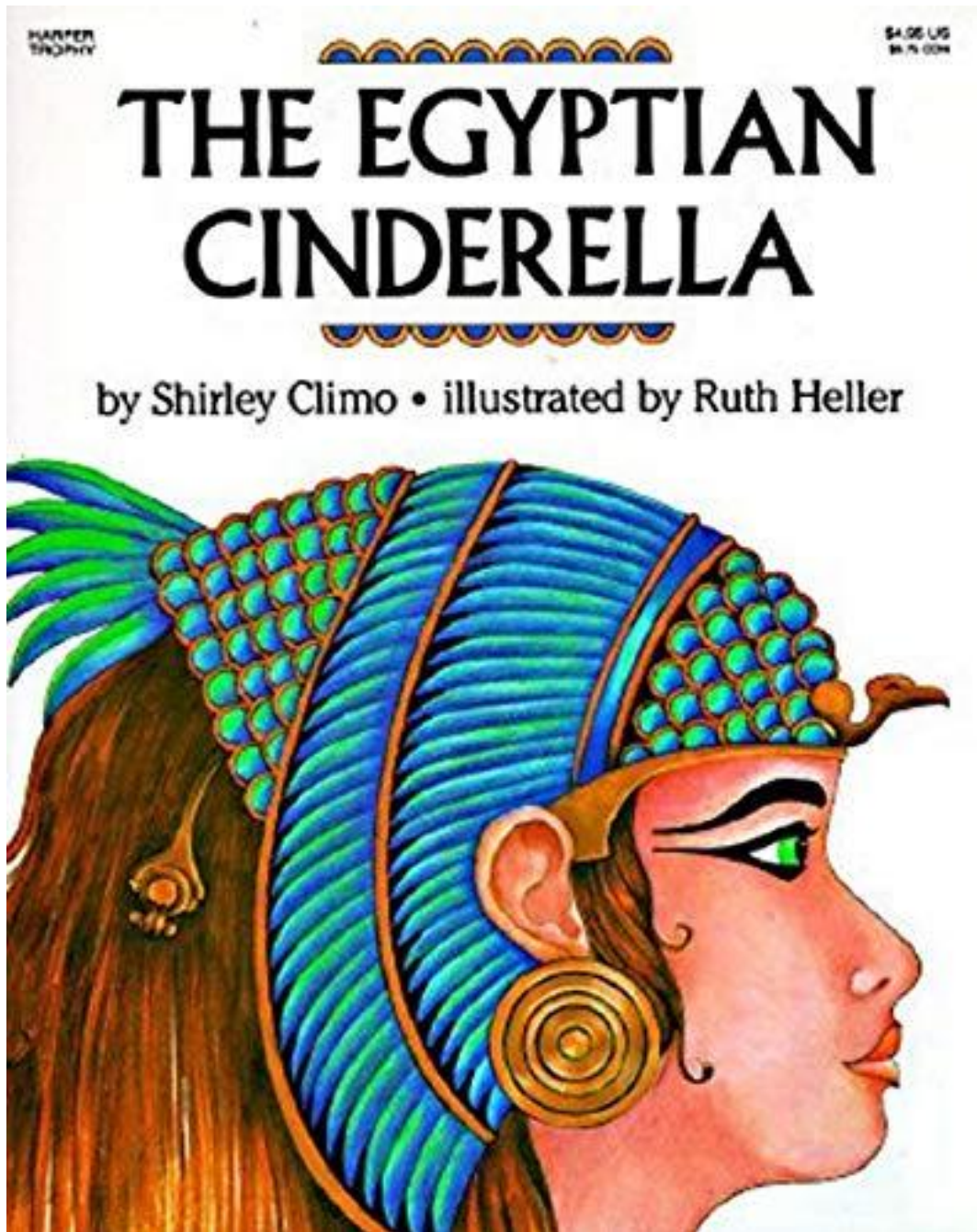
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# HOMEWORK
