Parents Survey

Thank-you to everyone who returned our recent Parents Survey along with all your comments about the school. The results of the survey have been discussed by the governors.

We were delighted with your feedback:

- 98.4% believe their child makes good progress at school
- 100% feel their child is taught well at school.
- 96.3% like the introduction of Times Tables Rock Stars
- 92.7% like the introduction of the Daily Mile

We also received some feedback regarding the days that evening events are held in school. You may know that the school is used by the community on many evenings of the week. As a school, we keep Thursday evening free so that we are able to hold our PTA events, and others too. We have varied the days of other events that are held during the day, following last year's feedback.

New Management Information System in School – Pupil Asset

As you may remember from February's newsletter, we are now using a different system in our office for holding information, called Pupil Asset.

You will recently have received a letter inviting you to download the Pupil Asset App to your phone / mobile device. Please make sure you do this so that you don't miss any important information.

Over the summer term, we will stop using Gateway, and switch all our systems of communication to Pupil Asset. Look out for any letters informing you of the changes as they take place.
