In order to ensure these arrangements work effectively, please adhere to the following:

- Seek tests via testing centres rather than via postal tests as this can significantly delay confirmation of results. Results are normally forthcoming in 24 hours via test centres.
- Notify school if children have symptoms after schools close (as outlined above) even when waiting for a test result, families can be advised to take necessary steps whilst awaiting confirmation.
