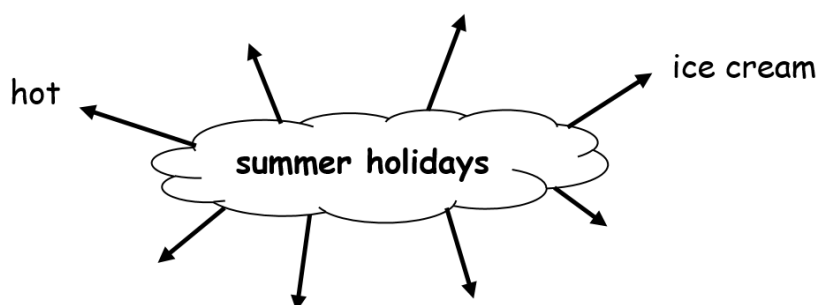


Writing a Story
