Swimming Kit

Again, hair will need to be tied back and earrings out.

The children should bring this in a separate bag, ready to change into, in the afternoon.



Homework

What will my child need to do each week?

- A task, relating to one of our topics, will be stuck into their Homework book and they can complete it over the double page. This aims to be creative and engaging for the children.
- Maths task – This alternates between a sheet and Mathletics.
- TTRS session
- Daily reading
- Practice spellings related to our spelling rule in their home-school books.



Homework

How long should my child spend doing each task?

- Aim for at least 5 minutes of TTRS every day
- Aim to read for at least 10 minutes a day (an adult to sign in the home-school book). Minimum 3 times a week.
- Around 30 minutes for the English-based task
- Around 15 minutes for the Maths task

Home-school books will be handed in on a Monday for us to check reading and spellings.

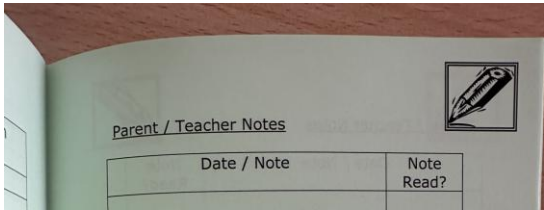
