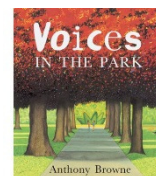

Voices in Priory Park



Focus Book: Voices in the Park Anthony Browne

English

The children will read a range of Anthony Browne books over the next half term, focusing on the story Voices in the Park for the main English unit. By the end of the unit, the children will be writing their own story in the style of Anthony Browne; making their own characters along the way. The children will use conjunctions, time-fronted adverbials and adverbs to develop their stories. The children will also develop their speaking and listening skills by recalling some of the author's stories using talk for writing, and by having opportunities in class to describe characters orally.

Maths

We will be studying these mathematical areas:
Time, Mental addition, subtraction, multiplication and division using known number facts.
Statistics and data handling.
Addition and subtraction using written methods of 3 digit numbers.
Problem solving by using logical procedures.
Adding fractions with the same denominator and finding simple equivalent fractions.

Science

What is a plant and what does it need to grow?
Could we grow any plant in this country, if not, why not?
What is the function of the seed? What do we mean by seed dispersal and why is it so important for our plants?
What is the function of the other parts of a plant?
What happens to the water that you put into the soil to help a plant grow?
Why is it so important for us to look after the bees in our country?
How can you make a presentation to show the life cycle of a plant?

History / Geography

Who were The Rowley Family and why are they important to St Neots?
Why/how did people come to settle in St Neots?
What was the benefit of the St Neots Town Council buying Priory Hill House?
Can you find anything in St Mary's Church that has a connection with The Rowley Family?
How did The Rowley Family live?
How are our lives similar and different to people of the past?
Who are the famous people from St Neots?

Art and Design

The children will be exploring blossom paintings and mixing colours to paint their own versions.

Technology

DT will be covered in the second half term.

Computing

In addition to using animation software, the children will be creating their own worlds to explore using LegoWeDo.

PE

Quick Cricket skills and Dance.

Perseverance

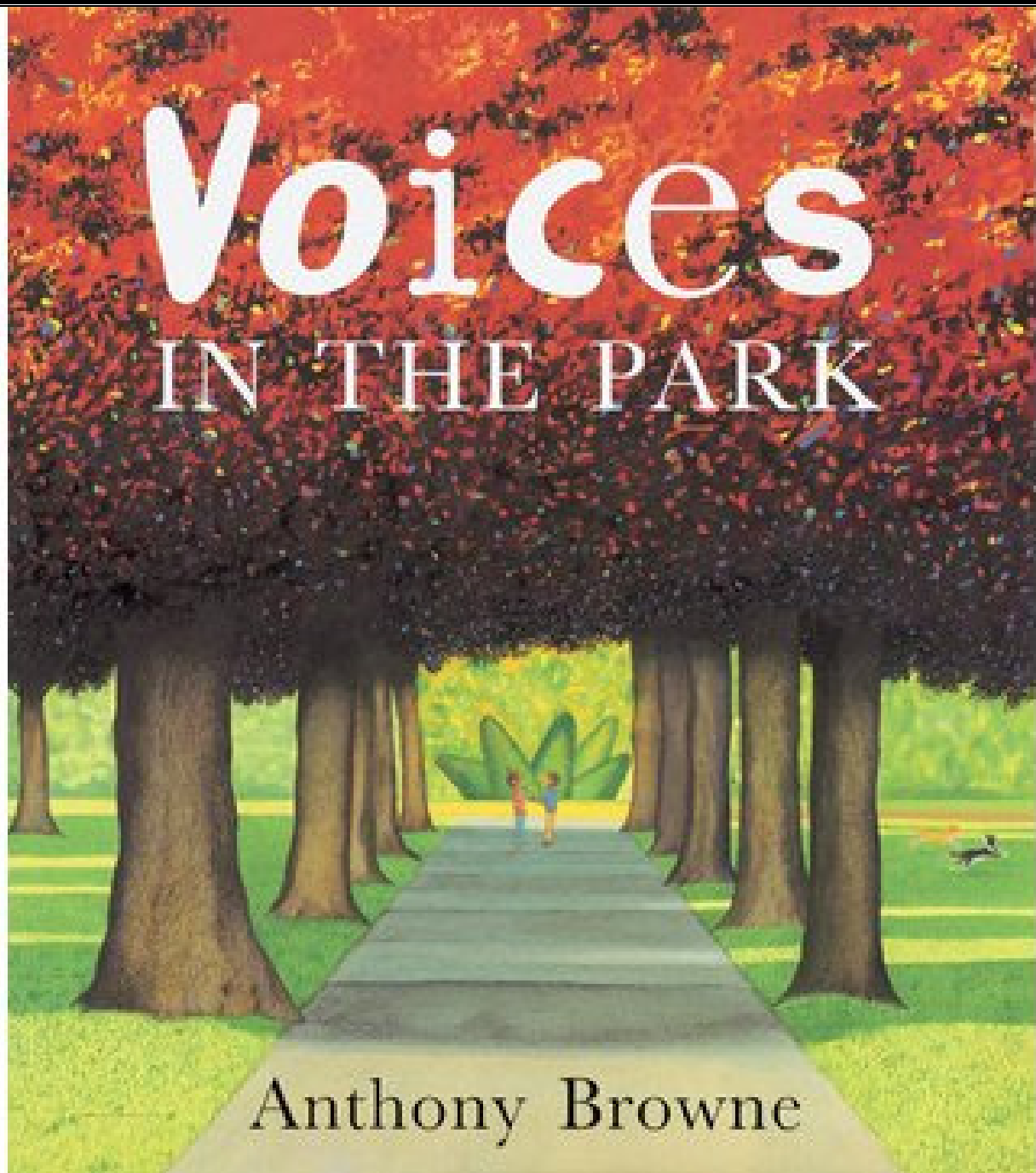
We will be learning to improve designs and how to improve our PE skills.
