World War II Airforce Officers

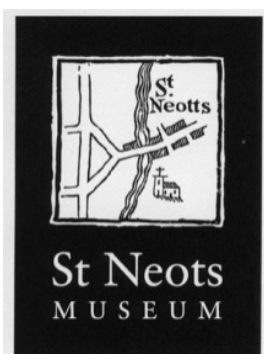
